Tool makes maths easier

GOLD Coast software developer Eduss has created a program to provide students with customised, computer-based mathematics and literacy tuition.

The program is to be used in more than 100 Queensland schools, the first of which is Broadbeach Primary on the Gold Coast.

Versions of the software — a complex, integrated learning tool accessible to inexperienced computer users — are being exported to South Africa.

Eduss plans to launch it in Europe and the UK soon, and says it can be translated into any language for use in any country.

Queensland Innovation and Information Minister Paul Lucas says the program will make learning maths and literacy easier. It tests and evaluates a student's knowledge of a subject, and determines their level of understanding.
