# School boost

Enfield Public School has joined a scheme directed at increasing mathematics and English results by giving each student a “take-home teacher”.

Principal Roger Rieger said the school has received a grant of software to the value of \$25,000 to help establish the innovative Eduss Trek system for teachers, students and parents.

Eduss Trek is a home-based interactive learning companion that uses the local school curriculum as a map to pin-point each child’s progress.
